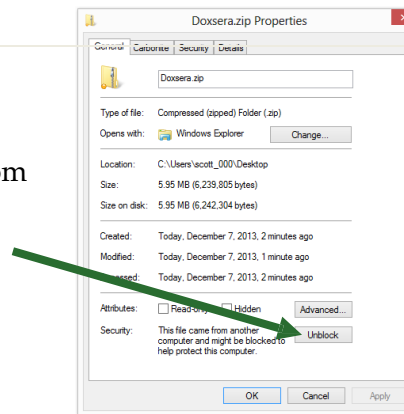


Installing Aurora

Step 1: Is the Zip Folder Blocked?

Windows sometimes blocks downloaded *folders* to protect you from viruses.

Right-click the **Aurora.zip** file you downloaded and choose **Properties**. If you see an **Unblock** button, click it to unblock the folder, then click **Apply, OK**.



Turn off all computer security systems before opening the installation .docm file!

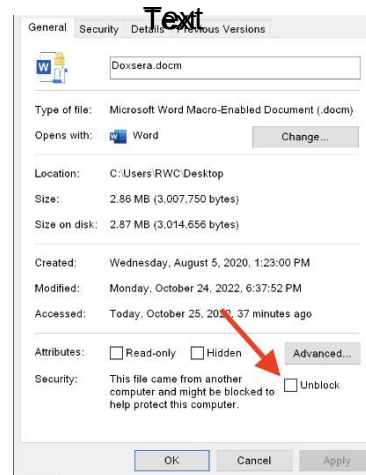

Step 2: Is the Program Blocked?

Windows often blocks downloaded *files* to protect you from viruses.

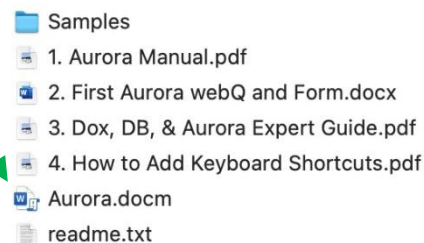
Right-click the **Aurora** file you extracted and choose **Properties**. If you see an **Unblock** button, click it to unblock the file, then click **Apply, OK**.



Step 3: Open the Installation File

Double-click the **Aurora** file.

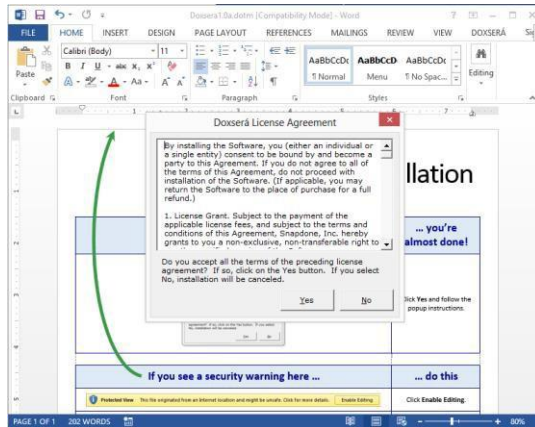
Open the file you downloaded to see its contents.



Depending on whether file extensions are visible on your computer, you may see **.docm** at the end of the filename.

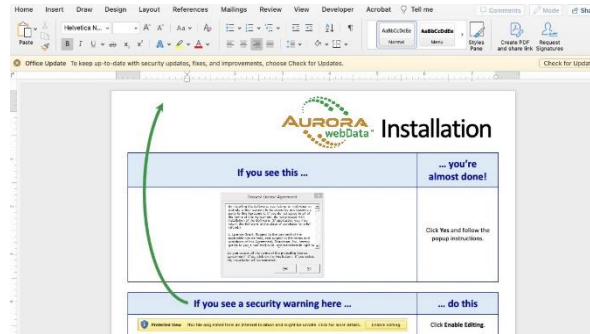
Step 4: Security Warnings?

If you see this ...



You're almost done. Click **Yes** to the license agreement, then **OK** to install.

If you see this ...

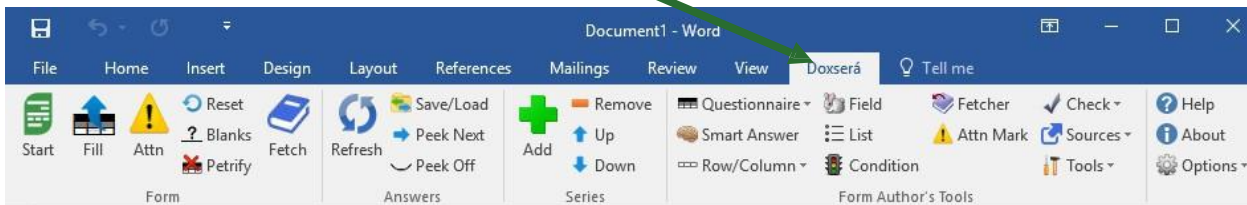


Follow the on-screen instructions to respond to your computer's security warnings.

Depending on Windows and Microsoft Word settings, you may need to respond to one or more security warnings before installation can proceed. Make certain that your security systems are turned completely off.

Step 5: Close and Reopen Word

Close Microsoft Word completely, including all open documents. When you reopen Microsoft Word, you'll find a new tab on the ribbon menu labeled **Aurora**. Click that tab to reveal **Aurora** commands.



If the **Aurora** tab does not appear, try restarting your computer. If that doesn't work, please use the [Diagnostics Portal](#) or [Request Form](#) so we can help you get started.

Step 6: Enter License Code

To activate **Aurora**, click  **Options, License code** and enter the registered name and license code we emailed to you.

Step 7: Sharing Information on a Network

Aurora initially saves program information on your local computer. But if your firm owns more than one license, you will likely want to share program information with other people in your office. To do so, click  **Options, Path** and enter the path to a shared folder on your network.

Step 8: Updates
